DECLARATION OF JESUS ROMERO

I, Jesus Romero, declare as follows:

1. I am an individual over the age of 18. I am the named plaintiff in the above-reference action. I have personal knowledge of the facts set forth below and if called to testify I could and would do so competently.

2. I was employed by Defendant JMS Interiors, Inc. ("Defendant") from May to September of 2024. I worked as an hourly, non-exempt employee.

3. The wage statements issued to me by Defendant did not list the pay period start and end dates, as required by California Labor Code Section 226(a)(6).

4. I am proud of the result and accomplishment of this lawsuit. I feel that it is a positive accomplishment and understand that other people will benefit because of the actions that I have taken.

5. I have discussed the terms of the settlement with my attorneys, and based on the information provided, I believe the settlement to be fair, adequate, and reasonable for myself and for the entire Class.

6. I am aware and have been aware from the inception of the case, that there is the risk that if I do not win my case, then I could be liable for Defendant's litigation fees and costs. I also understand that filing a case on my own behalf could have involved fewer costs and resolved faster than filing a class action. I accepted that risk in this case.

7. I also understood that filing this lawsuit is a public record and I accepted that burden. As such, I risked my future employment in order to bring this action. Moreover, this lawsuit, which is a public record, is something that potential employers can look into, and which may cause a negative impact of my employment prospects.

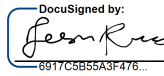
