The Motion for Preliminary Approval of Class Action and PAGA Settlements (the "Motion") filed by Plaintiff Torres came before this Court in Department 2. The Court, having considered the proposed Class Action Settlement Agreements, as well as all the papers filed, arguments by counsel, and affidavits hereby makes the preliminary finding that the proposed class action settlements are fair, reasonable, adequate and in the best interests of the proposed classes of workers who currently or formerly were employed with Defendant Quaglino Roofing. Good cause appearing therefore, the Court **GRANTS** the Motion and **ORDERS** as follows:

PROPOSED ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR PRELIMINARY APPROVAL

1 1. This Court has jurisdiction over the subject matter of the action and over all
2 parties to the Action, including all the putative class members.

3 2. The Court conditionally certifies a class action of harmed employees for
4 settlement purposes under CRC § 3.769;

5 3. The Court grants preliminary approval of the Class Action Settlement
6 Agreements where parties have agreed to a Gross Settlement Amount (“GSA”) of
7 \$1,975,000.00 to resolve class-based wage and hour, class-based discrimination/harassment
8 and an individual tort cause of action;

9 4. The Court appoints Plaintiff Pablo Torres Santiago as Class Representative;

10 5. The Court appoints Deason Law, PC as Class Counsel;

11 6. The Court appoints APEX as the Settlement Administrator;

12 7. The Court approves the content and distribution methods of the proposed Class
13 Notices to members of the proposed classes of workers.

14 8. The Court hereby grants and schedules a final fairness hearing for _____,
15 2025, at Department 2 to consider and rule upon whether the Class Action Settlement
16 Agreements should be fully granted.
