**ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR
ATTORNEYS' FEES, COSTS, AND
SERVICE PAYMENT**

Hon. Steve Kim

1 Plaintiff filed an unopposed motion for fees, costs, and service payment.
2 Plaintiff's motion came before the Court for hearing on January 7, 2026 in the District
3 Court for the Central District of California, the Honorable Steve Kim presiding. The
4 Court has reviewed the materials submitted by the parties and has heard arguments
5 presented by counsel at the hearing.

6 Based upon the pleadings, the submissions of all parties, declaration of counsel,
7 and the information presented at hearing, the Court finds that the requested attorneys'
8 fees, costs, and the service payment for Named Plaintiff are reasonable.

9 After a Preliminary Approval Hearing, this Court preliminarily approved the
10 Settlement, finding it fair, reasonable, and adequate; provisionally certified the class
11 and appointed representatives and class counsel; and approved the notice plan.

12 In compliance with the September 11, 2025, Preliminary Approval Order, the
13 notice plan was timely completed. Based upon the pleadings, the submissions of all
14 parties, declaration of counsel, and the information presented at hearing, the Court finds
15 that the requested attorneys' fees, costs, and the service payment for Named Plaintiff
16 are warranted.

17 Accordingly, the Court hereby **approves** the requested attorneys' fees, costs, and
18 the Named Plaintiff service payment in full. Specifically, the Court finds:

- 19 1. The requested attorneys' fees in the amount of \$350,000.00 (25% of the gross
20 settlement fund) is reasonable and is approved.
- 21 2. The requested reimbursement of costs in the amount of up to \$22,000.00 from
22 the gross settlement fund is reasonable and is approved. Any unused costs must
23 be reallocated to Class Members included in the settlement on a pro rata basis.
- 24 3. The administration costs of \$6,223.00 is reasonable and shall be paid to
25 Simpluris, Inc., the Settlement Administrator, from the gross settlement fund for
26 its duties in administering the settlement.
- 27 4. A single Service Payment of \$10,000.00 for Class Representative Albert Simic
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1 is fair and reasonable for his work on this case, his service to the Class, and for
2 a separate release of his personal claims, and is to be paid from the gross
3 settlement amount.
