**TO THE HONORABLE COURT, THE PARTIES AND THEIR ATTORNEYS OF
 RECORD:**

IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED by and between Plaintiff Odalys A Eguizabal Perez (“Plaintiff”) and Defendant Opya, Inc. (“Defendant”) (collectively, the “Parties”) through their respective and undersigned attorneys, as follows:

RECITALS

WHEREAS, Plaintiff and Defendant entered into a stipulation of settlement of PAGA action on April 10, 2026;

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1 WHEREAS, the Court issued the Order and Judgment approving the settlement on April 13, 2026,
2 and ordered Defendant to fully fund the settlement within 60 days of the Effective Date—April 13, 2026—
3 such that the full settlement amount is due on or before June 13, 2026;

4 WHEREAS, Defendant has since experienced financial hardship, which renders it unable to fund
5 the settlement as described in the Order and Judgment dated April 13, 2026;

6 WHEREAS, Defendant anticipates being able to fully fund the settlement if it could make equal
7 payments in the amount of \$17,500 over twelve (12) months with the first payment due no later than
8 August 15, 2026.

9 WHEREAS, the Parties have met and conferred about the proposed amended funding schedule.

10 WHEREAS, the Parties agree that because this is a PAGA-only settlement, no notice to the
11 Aggrieved Employees is required.

12 **STIPULATION**

13 WHEREFORE the Parties, by and through their attorneys of record, stipulate to and respectfully
14 request this Court's entry of an order as follows:

15 1. That the Court order Defendant to fully fund the settlement in equal payments in the
16 amount of \$17,500 over twelve (12) months with the first payment due no later than August 15, 2026.

17 2. Thereafter, Defendant shall fund each monthly installment on the 15th of each month
18 ending on July 15, 2027. To the extent the 15th of a particular month falls on a weekend, Defendant shall
19 be required to fund the next business day.

20 3. No notice is required to Aggrieved Employees because this is a PAGA-only matter.

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1 4. Plaintiff shall submit a copy of any order granting the requested funding modification to
2 the Labor and Workforce Development Agency (“LWDA”) through the Agency’s online filing system
3 within ten (10) days after entry of the order, pursuant to Labor Code section 2699, subdivisions (s)(3) and
4 (s)(4).
