2 The Court, having considered Plaintiff's Application for Approval of PAGA Settlement,
3 the Settlement Agreement, and all supporting evidence, hereby ORDERS:

4 **1. Approval of Settlement**

5 The Court finds the Settlement is **fair, reasonable, and adequate** under Labor Code §
6 2699(1)(2) and approves it in full.

8 **2. Settlement Amount**

9 The Court approves the **\$75,000 Gross Settlement Amount**, allocated as follows:

- 10 • LWDA Payment: \$26,000
11 • Aggrieved Employees: \$14,000
12 • Attorneys' Fees: \$25,000
13 • Costs: \$1,500
14 • Administration: up to \$3,500
15 • Service Award: \$5,000

17 **3. Distribution**

18 Payments shall be made in accordance with the Settlement Agreement, including pro rata
19 allocation based on pay periods.

20 **4. Release**

21 All aggrieved employees are deemed to release PAGA claims as defined in the Settlement.

23 **5. Administrator**

24 The Court approves the appointment of the Settlement Administrator.

25 **6. Judgment**

26 Judgment is entered consistent with the Settlement.

2 The Court retains jurisdiction to enforce the Settlement.
