**[PROPOSED] ORDER AND JUDGMENT
APPROVING PAGA SETTLEMENT**

20 **ORDER APPROVING PAGA SETTLEMENT AND JUDGMENT**

21 1. The Court, having reviewed and considered the Stipulation Approving PAGA Settlement,
22 the accompanying Memorandum of Points and Authorities, the Declaration of Manny Starr, the
23 Declaration of JulieAnne Cabrera, and the Declaration of Lisa Mullings, and good cause appearing,
24 hereby ORDERS AND ADJUDGES as follows:

25 2. The Court approves the settlement of the PAGA claims in the above-captioned action in the
26 gross amount of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00). The Court finds that the settlement represents
27 a fair, reasonable, and adequate compromise of disputed claims, given the strength of Plaintiffs'
28 claims, the risks of continued litigation, the defenses available to Defendants, and the recent

1 amendments to the Private Attorneys General Act of 2004.

2 3. The Court approves ILYM Group as Settlement Administrator and approves their fees in the
3 amount of \$2,500.00, to be paid from the Gross Settlement Amount.

4 4. After deduction of the Settlement Administrator's fees, the remaining Net Settlement
5 Amount of \$7,500.00 shall be distributed as follows: a. Sixty-five percent (65%) or \$4,875.00 shall
6 be paid to the California Labor and Workforce Development Agency (LWDA); and b. Thirty-five
7 percent (35%) or \$2,625.00 shall be distributed to the Aggrieved Employees according to the
8 allocation formula set forth in the Settlement Agreement.

9 5. Upon final distribution of the settlement funds, all PAGA claims asserted in this action and
10 in *Wendy Romero v. The Green Ant LLC and Trinity MA, Inc. dba Happy Leaf Collective*, LASC
11 Case No. 24LBCV02218, are deemed fully released and satisfied as to Defendants Trinity MA Inc.
12 d.b.a. Happy Leaf Collective and The Green Ant.

13 6. Judgment is hereby entered against Defendants Trinity MA Inc. d.b.a. Happy Leaf
14 Collective and The Green Ant in the amount of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) for civil
15 penalties pursuant to Labor Code section 2699 et seq. This action is hereby DISMISSED WITH
16 PREJUDICE as to all PAGA claims. All other claims resolved pursuant to the separate individual
17 settlement agreements shall be dismissed by the parties in accordance with those agreements.

18 7. The Court retains jurisdiction over the interpretation, implementation, administration, and
19 enforcement of this settlement and judgment.
